

PUBLIC ANNOUNCEMENT: NGS OFFICE CLOSURE NOTIFICATION

National Geographic Society (NGS), an International Non-Government Organization dedicated to exploring and protecting our planet, will be closing its operations in Rwanda effective 31ST June 2021.

Over the past 5 years NGS has built and expanded its program in Africa, leading to a significant increase in the total number of scientists and conservationists from East Africa funded by National Geographic grants for scientific work in the region. Specifically, they have awarded 147 grants across East Africa (Kenya, Tanzania, Uganda, Rwanda, DRC, and Burundi), of which 19 projects were funded in Rwanda.

Due to organization changes, NGS will be closing its operations in Rwanda and wishes to express sincere gratitude to its partners and the public for the impactful collaboration through the years and hereby presents the notification of the termination of NGS activities/operations as an INGO in Rwanda.
